Every man or woman who reaches out for help as they consider abortion has a unique story and must be met in a different way. Research has shown that an average of 2000 Staten Island women a month search the internet, during the middle of the night, looking for the abortion pill and other options of abortion. We are very focused in reaching these women with our services at the beginning of their searches and are investing much of our time to create a loving and compelling "first impression" to all who engage with us through the internet. Our refreshed website will be available in a few weeks, so please be sure to check it out.

Each volunteer brings a unique gift and calling to do God's work. As we begin 2022, we pray that you would consider volunteering with us as a counselor, an outreach event representative, or a donation team member. Your participation, in the work God is doing, can literally make the difference between life and death for another human being, waiting to be born.

### Highlights

We received a call from a pregnancy care center from a southern state asking us to check on a pregnant woman who had relocated to Staten Island. This young woman was abortion minded and in an abusive relationship. We were able to connect with the maternity home that she currently We are very blessed to be able to operate fully and effectively using a Mobile, or "Pop Up" Model. This means that Our Hot Line is up and running. Board members and volunteers are actively picking up donations of formula and infant ware and equipment as they are offered to us for our clients. All without the added expense of an office suite.

Our strategic plan is to strengthen and formalize this model going forward. I am working on developing "Pop Up" counseling sites at local churches and ministries around Staten Island. The goal is to have at least six sites throughout the island to be used for in-person counseling. Gateway Church has graciously donated a temporary office space for me to use to conduct the administrative tasks of the PCC of NY. Thank you, Pastor Mike, and Gateway Church, for this wonderful blessing!


