Dear friends,

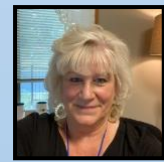

## Outreach Coordinator – Jessica Bocaya

Hello everyone, it's exciting to reconnect with you all through our newsletter! I want to get straight to the good news! This month we've had some amazing testimonies unfold and I would like to share one of my favorites.

A young lady reached out to us through a web inquiry requesting pregnancy support. She said it was her first time pregnant and she was only 21 years old, expecting to give birth December 6th. She was desperate, with only a pack of diapers given to her by her nurse and nothing more. She felt unprepared, alone and defeated. I contacted her and she said she received a business card from someone who likely attended one of our outreaches.

After speaking with her, I discovered that she was not connected to a church and had no religious background. She knew of God as a child because her mom attended a Catholic church. I asked her if she would like to be connected to a church family who would love and support her, and I asked if she would like to raise her child in the faith. She said yes! We prayed together on the phone and she began to weep.

I checked her zip code and she was in close proximity to ICC. We made arrangements for her to attend a Friday evening service and she showed up! We had tons of supplies to offer her including baby wipes, diapers, clothing, blankets, diaper bags, stroller and more! She was overwhelmed with joy! At the end of the service, she came to the alter and asked Pastor Ron if he would pray for the "future of her baby." The ladies of the church were so accommodating, sitting next to her throughout the service, embracing her when she wept and helping her to the car with all the items — including a Bible with beautiful hand written notes and the phone numbers from our ladies that loved on her throughout the service.



The following morning, I received a beautiful message from her via text and it stated "Good morning, I wanted to thank you. I don't really know how to thank you for everything you did for me. Last night was something new to me, accepting and praying to God like I used to do before, and asking for strength and motivation for my baby and me. May God bless you multiple times for you and your family."

We thank God for the opportunity to win another soul for the kingdom! Praise the Lord!!

Can you believe that next month I will celebrate my one year anniversary as the Director of the PCC? Wow! Time goes by fast.

It's humbling to serve and see God's hand moving in Staten Island. I have a front row seat to see honest to goodness heart transformation and hope. We continue to build trust in the community and now we are receiving phone calls from Social Workers in the local hospitals, looking for our help for women on the maternity floors. These women have escaped dangerous situations and need assistance in all areas. This month we have assisted six women and provided four car seats to new moms, so they are able to leave the hospital. Care seats and clothing that are prayed over for the child's protection moving forward.

We are thankful to you, our donors, who are supporting all our efforts here on Staten Island. Please continue to pray for me and for the Pregnancy Care Center.
