Care Net, the national Pregnancy Care organization that we are an affiliate of, noted recently that the federal government just announced it will fund a "national abortion hotline."

When a woman finds out she is facing an unplanned pregnancy, she needs compassion, hope, and accurate information regarding all her options, including the emotional cost and health risks associated with abortion. Yet the government wants to fund a hotline where the only choice offered is abortion, while ignoring the science about its risks. That's why the government is using the controversial Title X grant program, a key funding source for abortion giants like Planned Parenthood, to finance their new referral line.
