CompassCare

Because all people are made in the Image of God and are therefore equally valuable, CompassCare is dedicated to erasing the need for abortion by transforming a woman's fear into confidence.

CompassCare stands as a bold and compassionate leader in New York City, providing life-affirming medical care to women facing unplanned pregnancies. As the only ethical medical alternative in NYC, CompassCare now serves three boroughs—Staten Island, the Bronx, and Brooklyn—meeting women where they are with both professional care and genuine compassion.

Through its partnership with the Pregnancy Care Center of New York, CompassCare offers medical services on Staten Island from the PCCofNY center in Dongan Hills. Services include free pregnancy testing, limited ultrasounds, STD testing and treatment, and abortion pill reversal.

In a culture where fear often drives decision-making, CompassCare offers a different path—one rooted in dignity, truth, and hope. Their work reflects a deep commitment to protecting life, strengthening families, and ensuring that no woman feels alone in her moment of need. We are honored to recognize CompassCare for their unwavering dedication to serving women and families across New York City.

Jason J. McGuire (Keynote Speaker)

Jason J. McGuire serves as the Executive Director of the New York Families Foundation and its affiliated organization, New York Families Action. Since joining the organization in 2007, he has been instrumental in its growth and statewide impact.

A passionate defender of Christian values—including the sanctity of life, the sacredness of marriage, religious freedom, and justice—Mr. McGuire calls individuals and communities to live out these truths with courage and conviction.

A respected voice across New York and the nation, Jason frequently speaks at churches and conferences and is sought after by media outlets for his insight on public policy and government. His radio broadcasts reach audiences across the state, equipping and informing thousands of believers.

Because of his convictions, Mr. McGuire has personally experienced the cost of standing firm in his faith. In 2025, following legal action brought by Letitia James, he served 53 days of intermittent incarceration—an experience that reflects his unwavering commitment to truth, no matter the cost.

Mr. McGuire holds a Bachelor of Theology from Andersonville Theological Seminary and previously served as pastor of Ingleside Christian Church in Naples, New York. He and his wife, Lorene, have been married since 1996 and are blessed with four children—three at home and one with the Lord.
